- (7) Upon tendering my membership fees I may at the discretion of the manager and subject to the availability of space be allowed to store or moor my boat at the Squadron. I enter into this agreement to persuade the Squadron to permit me to store my boat at the Squadron, and to permit me to use its facilities. This agreement becomes effective as soon as I commence storage or mooring of my boat, and mooring of my boat, and using the facilities at the Squadron. It continues, for the purpose of enforcement until my obligations to the Squadron have been satisfied.
- (8) I will notify the squadron of any change of address or telephone number.
- (9) I have read, understand and accept the Squadron's schedule of charges and rules and regulations and such changes as may be adopted by the Board of the Squadron from time to time. I agree to place the Squadron's decal on my boat or trailer, and to maintain it in a legible state at all times.
- (10) I understand and accept that the Squadron is not able or obliged to protect my boat or other property against theft, damage, storms, fire or other losses, including losses or damage to equipment.
- (11) I understand and accept that boat storage location is at the discretion of the manager and dockmaster and/or the Board of Directors, who may move the boat or cause me to move the boat for the benefit of the Squadron. I further understand and accept that any boat moored or tied alongside any dock, wave fence or other area (except the use of allocated slips by the tenants thereof) for more than 24 hours without the permission of the manager may be moved or anchored or brought elsewhere for the convenience of the Squadron and at the risk of the owner.
- (12) I understand that I am to keep my boat, trailer and/or mooring in a good state of repair. I am also responsible for the removal of any debris created by the storage or use of my boat.
- (13) I agree to be responsible for any damage that I or my crew or guests or my boat may cause to Squadron property, or to other persons or boats stored or moored at the Squadron. I will indemnify the Squadron against loss by reason of my negligence or the negligence of my crew or guests or those entrusted with the use of my boat.
- (14) Breach of any obligation undertaken in this agreement may, in addition to all other remedies which are authorized at law and equity, be the basis for causing my membership to be terminated, the removal of my boat from Squadron property and remedies described in paragraphs 17 and 18 below.
- (15) I understand that the demand for boat storage exceeds supply. It is the desire of the Squadron to promote sailing and racing through the use of its facilities. Active boat use is therefore required. Passive boat storage denies opportunities to those who want to use Squadron facilities for active sailing. I agree to use my boat a minimum of one (1) time a month for a minimum of six (6) months each calendar year.

- (16) When it is determined that the owner's boat is not being used as required, the owner may be notified. If the required boat usage does not begin within 30 days of such written notice, then the owner's normal storage charges will be increased by \$5.50 per foot, per month, plus sales tax for all subsequent periods. Legal action may be taken to remove the boat from the Squadron's premises.
- (17) The manager or an officer of the Squadron may write to the boat owner asking for removal of the vessel within 30 days of such notice. The boat owner may request a hearing before the Board on the facts, at the next meeting of the Board of Directors. The hearing shall be requested by writing to the Squadron before the 30-day period expires. In lieu of a personal appearance, a boat owner may file within the 30-day period one or more statements challenging the claim of failure to use the boat as required.
- (18) Should the boat owner not reply during the 30-day period, or should the Board not grant an extension of time or not be persuaded by the boat owner of the facts concerning the required use, the boat may be removed by the Squadron from the Squadron premises immediately. It may be removed to any point outside the Squadron premises (including but not limited to the public land, roadway or park outside the Squadron). The increased costs of storage elsewhere, risks of vandalism, theft and other damage resulting from such removal will be the responsibility of the owner.
- (19) If a member does not plan to renew his membership, he must remove his boat by January 1 of the year in which his membership will lapse or be immediately subject to a storage rate of \$10.00/ft/mo.
- (20) I further understand that if I am delinquent in paying storage charges or other obligations, that the Squadron may take action to collect or recover sums due. In addition to all remedies authorized by law or equity, the Squadron may impound, seize or remove to another location any boats or trailers or other property that I may have stored at the Squadron for the purpose of removing such property or of asserting a lien on such property. Such lien may be asserted and enforced by a public or private sale or through the courts as the Squadron may elect (paragraph 5).
- (21) To show my good faith to this organization I tender my Credit Card number with the understanding that the Squadron will only use it in the event that there is a long term outstanding balance on my account.

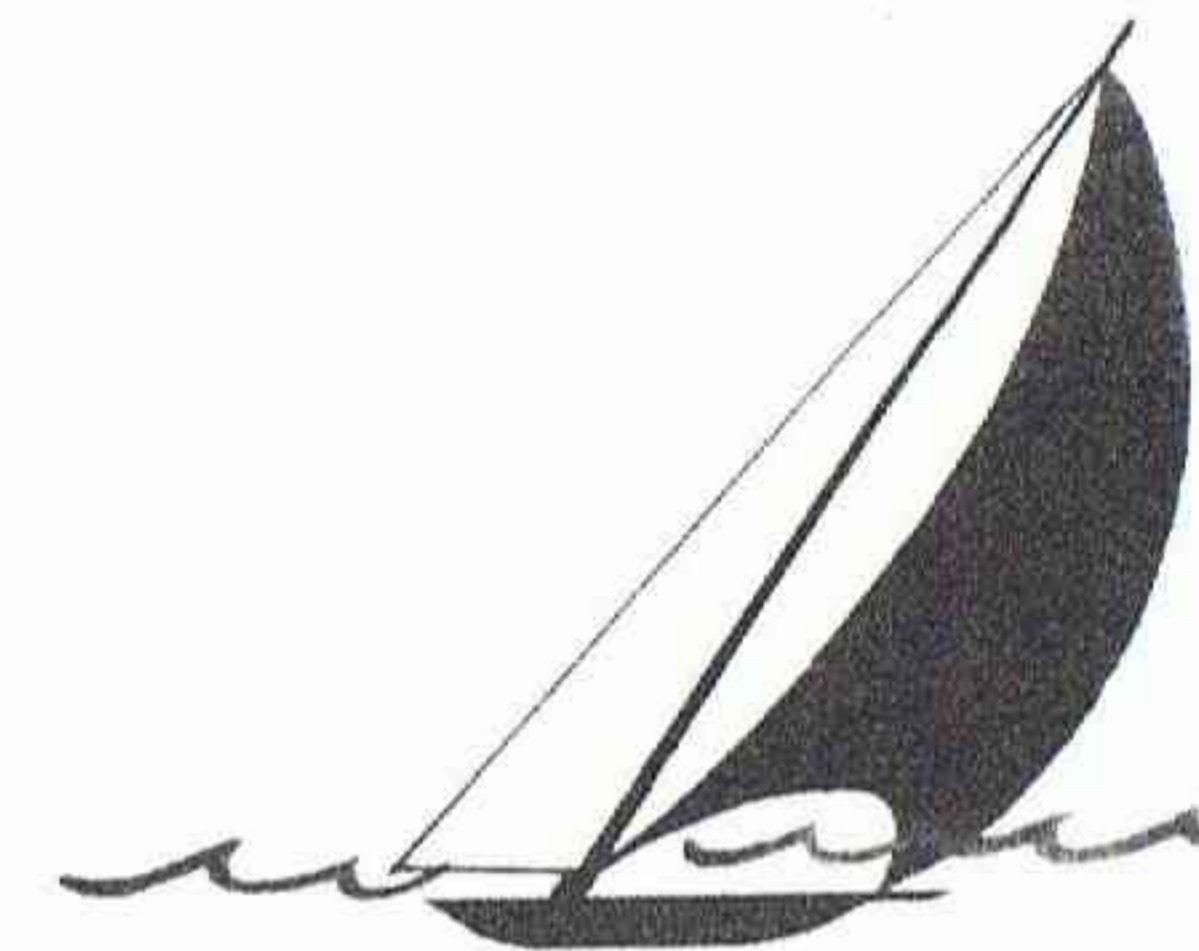

ACTIVITIES

RACING

Racing for cruiser-racers and one-designs occurs on the first and third Sunday, September through May, and every Friday night from April to October. Perpetual races for all classes are held October to May on Saturday. Small one-designs race from April to September on alternating Saturdays in the evening. The Squadron hosts a series of state, regional, national and international events at various times during the year.

CRUISING

The Squadron's cruising group sponsors monthly weekend cruises. These could be a sail to nearby Lido in the moonlight or a special long weekend to Boca Grande or Tampa Bay. Once-a-month Fullmooners' cruises are usually coupled with a potluck dinner at the club.

SOCIAL EVENTS

Variety best describes the social events at the Squadron. They are for sailors and non-sailors alike. A comprehensive schedule of events (listed on the back) offers something for everyone. Traditional events are the 4th of July picnic, the Halloween costume party, the Annual Christmas party and New Year's Eve celebration, and the Fireside Chat wine and cheese party.

EDUCATION

The Squadron cosponsors American Red Cross sailing classes year-round. Certified instructors provide both classroom instruction and on-the-water training in Sunfish and Bauer 12's, small sloops that are specifically designed for sailing instruction. Another program SALT, for handicapped sailors, is a more recent addition. The Youth Sailing Program teaches children from 8 to 18 the fundamentals of sailing and water safety in Opti's, Lasers and 420's. The Luffing Lassies, a women's organization, meets each Thursday for sailing instruction and racing competition. Officially from September to June but as of late has continued at a reduced level through the summer months.

PUBLICATIONS

Members receive a monthly newsletter, *The Burgee*, and a yearly phone list of current members and basic club information.

WORK PARTY

Weekly and monthly work parties are held to offset the Squadron's maintenance costs.

BOARD MEETINGS

Board meetings are held on the second Tuesday of each month. The time and date is announced in the *Burgee*.

FFOF CONCERTS

Friends of the Florida Folk hold concerts in the Pavilion on the last Monday of the month at 7:30 PM. Specific information can be found in the area newspapers and our monthly *Burgee*.

COMMITTEES

EDUCATION

Responsible for the overall coordination of educational activities conducted at the Squadron.

RACE

Responsible for the planning, organization and execution of all Squadron cruises. A cruising class for both experienced and novice sailors is conducted yearly.

ENTERTAINMENT

Responsible for Squadron social activities conducted at the club.

MEMBERSHIP

Responsible for directing new members into their area of interest.

CRUISE COMMITTEE

Responsible for organizing cruising activities.

MOORING COMMITTEE

Responsible for overseeing the condition of moored boats and condition of the moorings.

LONG RANGE PLANNING/BUILDING

Responsible for updating a plan to guide future development and yearly improvements to the Squadron's facility. Weekly and monthly Work Parties are held to offset maintenance costs.

In consideration of membership in the Sarasota Sailing Squadron, Inc., I agree:

- (1) To abide by all rules in force during my membership.
- (2) To pay all dues or fees applicable to me during my membership, which shall be debts if unpaid.
- (3) I am fully cognizant of the risks of sailing, and I understand and agree that the Sarasota Sailing Squadron, Inc. on-shore or off-shore facilities, including hoists, launching ramps, docks and moorings, shall be used solely at my own risk, and that no Squadron equipment will be used by any person other than myself. **SARASOTA SAILING SQUADRON, INC., AND THE CITY OF SARASOTA SHALL NOT BE LIABLE TO ME, MY FAMILY OR GUESTS FOR ITS OWN NEGLIGENCE OR FOR THE NEGLIGENCE OF ITS AGENTS, CONTRACTORS, EMPLOYEES, SERVANTS, INVITEES, LICENSEES OR CONCESSIONAIRES, WHICH NEGLIGENCE MIGHT ARISE IN WHOLE OR IN PART FROM THE USE OF SQUADRON PREMISES, EQUIPMENT OR PROPERTY.** Should there be accidental or negligent injury or loss of life or property, or any claim or suit made by me or a member of my family, or my guest or my invitee or a member of my crew or some person working on my boat - against the Squadron and the City of Sarasota, or its agents or employees or members - seeking damages by reason of accident or negligence relating to the property, mooring, equipment or races, or events held at or in connection with the Squadron, I will indemnify suits, damages, liability, expense brought by me, my guests, family, invitees, etc.
- (4) To be responsible for my own property, boat and equipment, and to protect it against loss, vandalism, theft or other damage, and to secure my property, mooring, boat and equipment in such a manner as it will not harm or damage any other persons or property which may come upon Squadron premises.
- (5) I understand that if storage charges due, if any, are not paid for more than 30 days after billing, upon 30 days notice by certified mail to me at my last address listed with the organization, that my boat or other property may be sold with out further legal process at a public or private sale and the proceeds be first applied to my debts, the remainder to be held for me for one year - after which (if not claimed by me during the year), the same shall be paid over to the organization for its general purposes. I also understand that this is not the exclusive means of collection available to the Squadron, who may seek other legal enforcement of any debt for storage. I further agree to pay the Squadron for any and all attorneys fees and cost incurred by the Squadron as a result of legal actions required to collect storage charges.
